# APPLE WINDOW CRAFT







### **MATERIALS NEEDED**

- 2 sheets of clear contact paper per child (approximately 13×9" each)
- 1 construction paper apple frame per child (I used red)
- 1 green construction paper leaf per child
- 1 black construction paper stem per child
- red, yellow and green tissue paper cut into approximately 1/2" squares
- scissors (students)

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARATION**

- Cut all of the necessary paper materials ahead of time. While students are away from their desks, place a sheet of clear contact paper sticky side up on each child's desk.
- Place one red apple frame, one leaf and one stem onto each piece of contact paper.
- Place a basket of pre-cut tissue paper squares within reach of each student.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR ASSEMBLY**


- Students fill the center of the apple with tissue paper squares.
- Once the center of the apple has been filled, place a second piece of construction paper (sticky side down) onto the apple. This will seal all of the tissue paper squares into place.
- Have students trim to remove excess plastic from around the edges of the apple.

I hang the completed apples in my classroom windows with a piece of clear scotch tape. It brightens the classroom and adds a personal touch from the students!

## **APPLE FRAME TEMPLATE**


Print this template on heavy cardstock, and cut on solid black line. Fold a 9x12" sheet of red construction paper or cardstock in half "taco style" and place the straight lines of the template along the seam.

# **APPLE LEAF PATTERN**

Print this page and copy onto green construction paper or cardstock. Place one green leaf at the top of each apple beside the stem.



# **APPLE STEM PATTERN**

Print this page and copy onto brown construction paper or cardstock. Place one stem at the top of each apple.
