



How to Make a Wizard's Hat

1. Cut two 1"x12" strips of blue foam, cardstock, or construction paper.
2. Using the two strips of foam, measure the circumference of your child's head. Overlap the strips a little bit and staple them together, then cut off the excess.
3. Print out and cut out the template on page 2 for the triangle part of the hat. Trace around the template on a blue piece of foam, cardstock, or construction paper. Then cut out the hat.
4. Have your kids decorate the blue triangle with yellow, white, or silver stars and moons (see page 2 for template).
5. Glue the bottom of the blue triangle behind the blue strips of paper on the opposite side of the staples so that it looks like a hat.
6. If your child wants to, they can decorate the brim of the hat too. Otherwise, it's done!
