

How to Make a Wizard's Hat

- 1. Cut two 1"x12" strips of blue foam, cardstock, or construction paper.
- 2. Using the two strips of foam, measure the circumference of your child's head. Overlap the strips a little bit and staple them together, then cut off the excess.
- 3. Print out and cut out the template on page 2 for the triangle part of the hat. Trace around the template on a blue piece of foam, cardstock, or construction paper. Then cut out the hat.
- 4. Have your kids decorate the blue triangle with yellow, white, or silver stars and moons (see page 2 for template).
- 5. Glue the bottom of the blue triangle behind the blue strips of paper on the opposite side of the staples so that it looks like a hat.
- 6. If your child wants to, they can decorate the brim of the hat too. Otherwise, it's done!
